## Cryptocurrencies with Values: The Seratio Faith Coin

### Abstract

The Centre for Citizenship Enterprise and Governance ([www.cceg.org.uk](http://www.cceg.org.uk)) is a global leading think tank on the movement of value established in the UK. It has provided standards for both financial and non-financial metrics for comprehensive legislation. The SeratioToken is a cryptocurrency for values helping market adoption for already commissioned Faith Coin, Women's Coin, City Coin, Edu Coin, Leadership Coin, Student Coin and other UN Sustainable Development Goals. The unique feature of the Seratio token (SER) is the ability to capture the financial assets, micro shares and provenance of transactions involving people, products, processes, projects and organisations.

### Biography

Prof. Ta'eed is the Director of the independent, not-for-profit Centre for Citizenship, Enterprise and Governance and Professor of Social Enterprise at the University of Northampton, and Visiting Professor in Capacity Development at Birmingham City University. He is Executive Editor of Social Value & Intangibles Review and The Efficiency Exchange. He is a world authority on the measurement of impact and has been a keynote speaker globally including at The Vatican. He is also Director of the Blockchain UN Lab, the UK£33.5m CyberFutures education foundation, and Chair of Seratio Ltd. He retired in 2008 from successful private sector career and is currently rolling out the UK's first Initial Coin Offering (ICO).
